Welcome!

Overview of 2022/23

Last year, our team supported **1,473 people** with sight and hearing loss. We provided **3518** interactions, including face to face support, drop in sessions and information and issued **489 pieces of free equipment**.

My thanks to our staff and volunteer team who worked tirelessly and creatively to meet the needs of **people in Perth and Kinross** with sight and or hearing loss - we are delighted to have helped so many people.

Since February 2022 we have been operating from the **High Street in Perth**, providing drop-in services for sight and hearing loss. We have seen an increase in footfall over the last 12 months and have raised greater awareness of the charity and the challenges people face with sight and or hearing loss.

Our vision is to create a **Sensory Hub**, a vibrant, central space, where people can connect with each other and receive information, practical help and advice to increase their independence. We are continuing to move ahead with this and hope to have this up and running by **Spring 2024**.

Our Volunteer and Activities coordinator joined us in November

2022 and we have weekly activities in Perth including social groups, swimming, music and talks. In rural communities our Re-connect project, funded by the Big Lottery, has gone from strength to strength, with six groups now running and more planned over the next 12 months.

Once the Sensory Hub is up and running we will have space to run in house groups/activities. We will be involving people with sight and or hearing loss to find out what they would like to have available to support them.

Growing our income, developing new services and establishing the Sensory Hub will be key priorities for the year ahead. We welcomed our Fundraising Manager in Feb 2023 and we have exciting plans for the next 12 months that I am sure you will join us and support.

Finally, I would also like to **thank our Trustees** for their time and our
clients and wider community for
supporting with our fundraising.
Legacies, general donations and
grants from charitable trusts all
enable us to continue to provide
support and enable people to live as
independently as possible.


