New Telephone Befriending Service

Our new Telephone Befriending Service, launched during Loneliness Week (9-15 June). The National Lottery Community Fund has funded this service.

The aim of the new service is to link up with people experiencing sight and/or hearing loss – and enable them to speak to someone regularly from the comfort of their own home.

Loneliness can be isolating, especially for those with sensory loss. A simple, friendly phone call once a week or fortnight could brighten someone's entire day – we want to break down barriers and provide this essential support.
